The AAL scholarship is given to an African-American student who has demonstrated leadership and academic excellence as a major or minor in a world language. S/he should be committed to promoting world languages within the African-American community.

Requirements for AAL Scholarship:

1. Must be a black/African-American college or university student
2. Must be a major or minor in world languages
3. Must submit a current transcript from your institution of higher education
4. Must have a 3.0 average in the major or minor
5. Must submit 1 letter of recommendation – The letter should be from one of your former or current world language educators
6. Must send a photograph of yourself
7. Must submit an essay which consists of the following:
 - Make a statement about your background and experiences and how you came to be interested in world language.
 - How do you feel as an African-American involved in the field of world languages?
 - How would you promote world language learning in the African-American community?
 - What are some of your short or long-term goals with relation to the world language that you are studying?
 - How might you use the scholarship proceeds?
