## Competition: 2010 Postcard Contest

**Theme:** Languages: The Original Social Networks- “Know Languages, Know Countries, Know People”

**Deadline:** September 18, 2010

**Prize:** Display at the FLANC 2011 Conference and at the SCOLT Student Showcase displayed on <[www.scolt.org](http://www.scolt.org)> and use in advocacy mailings.

The postcards are to be created by students, and the winners will be used as advocacy tools in mailings to state and national government representatives, school board members, and other community personnel. The winners will be chosen by attendees at the 2010 Annual FLANC Fall Conference.

## POSTCARD GUIDELINES

1. Postcard size: 4.25 x 5.5 inches; surface must be flat with no moving parts or additions.
2. No trademarks or copyrighted material may be used on the postcard.
3. All design must be on one side of the postcard; the student’s name, grade, and school must appear only on the back of the postcard. All design must be original (no clip art, for example), except for lettering (may be computer generated).
4. The primary/main theme (**in boldface below**) must appear on the front of the postcard; (sub theme optional; *in quotes below*); other words are permitted in any language.
5. 2010 Theme: **Languages: The Original Social Networks- “Know Languages, Know Countries, Know People”**
6. The design may be in color or black and white.
7. A teacher may submit one entry per level (K-5, 6-8, 9-12, or higher education).
8. If a teacher works at multiple schools, s/he may submit one entry per school.
